Frequently Asked Questions

When Do Classes Meet?

The TCESD No.2 will host Citizen Fire Academies throughout the year, one in the spring and one in the fall. Each Academy will meet for 4 Thursday evenings (7pm-9:30pm) and one Saturday (9am-2pm).

Where Are Classes Held?

The Travis County ESD No.2 Central Fire Station, located at 203 E. Pecan Street, Pflugerville, Texas.

How Much Does the Course Cost?

There is no charge to participants. All materials, along with T-shirt, are provided.

Who Can Attend?

Potential candidates for the Citizen Fire Academy must meet the following criteria:

- Minimum age of 18 years
- Live within TCESD No.2 boundaries.
- No prior felony arrests
- No Class-B misdemeanor arrests within five years of application

Who Are the Instructors?

A variety of instructors are used from the Firefighters on shift all the way up to the Fire Chief.

What Happens Upon Completion?

If desired, graduates will have the ability to support TCESD No. 2 in one of our various volunteer roles.
